- **Clinical data:**

- Critical limb ischemia
- Rest pain and ulcer at left foot
- ABI left 0.12
- Rutherford class 5
- W1 I 3 FI 1

- **Risk factors:**
 - Current smoker (50 pack-years)
 - Arterial Hypertension
 - Right iliac&Right renal artery stenting

- **Procedural Steps:**

1. Left femoral antegrade access

- 6F sheath (COOK)

2. Guidewire passage from antegrade

- Command 18/ 14/ Connect CTO wire (Abbott)

- Trailblazer support catheter (Medtronic)

- In case of failure: retrograde approach

3. PTA and DCB

- Predilatation: 3/200mm Passeo18 balloon (Biotronic)

- 3/200mm Dhalia DCB (Acotec)
